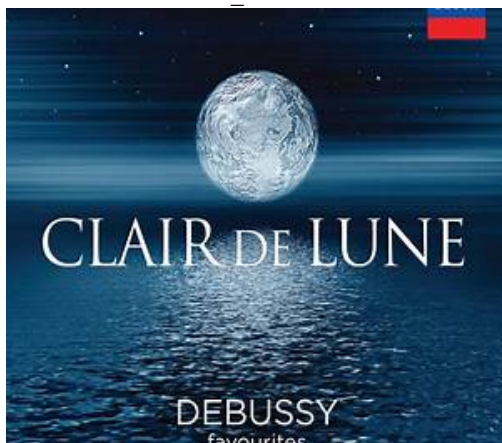

Beautiful book It portrays life of Claude Debussy You become strongly attached to the character his
